EMR UPDATES

Epic Notes

Special EPIC securities have been created for mid-level providers/physician extenders and mid-level students to address the co-signing of notes in EPIC. The work flow for co-signing Physician Extender / Physician Extender Student notes is now the same as it has been for Resident/Medical Student notes as listed below:

- The Student writes the note and clicks to "Share" the note.
- The Student will need to Communicate with the Physician Extender that the note has been created.
- The Physician Extender will select the Shared (Incomplete) note.
- The Physician Extender reviews/makes changes to the note, if warranted.
- The Physician Extender signs the note, and selects the Attending that will need to co-sign the note.

This process went into effect the week of February 13.

Sidebar Notes

While writing notes using the sidebar note capability, some physicians had reported error messages regarding the patients chart being locked. The eCovenant team found an issue with the sidebar note capability, and have temporarily disabled this function until we can get the fix in place. The fix is scheduled to be installed by the end of the month. Until then, the sidebar note will need to stay disabled. Once the fix is in, the eCovenant team will re-enable the sidebar note capability. Thank you for your patience in this matter.
