Order Required for Mammograms

As of January 1, 2018, the Covenant Breast Health Center will require either a written script or an electronic order for screening mammograms.

Physicians in our community have expressed concerns when receiving screening mammogram results on patients they have not recently seen. To be responsive to physician concerns, and to ensure the proper type of mammogram is performed, a written script or an electronic order will be required for all exams.

Medication Auto Stop Policy

Based on HFAP requirements, Covenant's Medication Auto Stop policy requires that medications without a stop date be reviewed every 30 days. Starting December 14th, a new best practice alert (BPA) will fire to alert you when your patient has medication orders that need review.
