Covenant Partners with the Michigan Spine Surgery Improvement Collaborative (MSSIC)

On March 4, 2015, Covenant HealthCare went "live" with MSSIC and is one of 22 hospitals statewide involved in the collaboration. Dr. Schinco is serving as Covenant's physician champion. MSSIC is a statewide, surgeon led, hospital collaborative sponsored by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan (BCBSM). The program focuses on spine surgeries, specifically on pain relief and restoration of function. Information will be collected on patient characteristics, treatment processes, and outcomes of care. With their colleagues around the state, surgeons will review the data and share their thoughts and observations to improve patient care. The aim will be to reduce post-operative complications and the need for further surgeries. They will also work together to develop consistent approaches to areas like post-surgical exercise, physical therapy, and returning to work.
