What is an Imaging and Diagnostic volunteer?

This is a Covenant HealthCare volunteer who has been trained by a staff radiographer to perform a variety of duties with oversight.

What duties can an Imaging & Diagnostic volunteer provide?

At Covenant HealthCare, we strive to provide the highest quality imaging for our physicians and our patients. That's why the Imaging and Diagnostic Department at Covenant HealthCare offers the most advanced radiology imaging equipment and state-of-the-science technology. I&D volunteers provide staff support and assistance for our patients. They will round with staff to assist with radiology duties and help in the department:

- Restock linen in radiography rooms
- Assist radiographer with patient exams
- Clean radiology rooms, portable units and aprons
- Adhere to the Covenant Values
- Warm-up rooms/tubes
- Transport portable units
- Transport C-arm/monitor for surgery
- Check/stock crash carts

- Keep exam rooms and portable units stocked with wipes, gloves, bags, etc.
- Make sure blanket warmer is stocked
- Provide excellent customer service to the patient
- Assist staff with transferring patients from stretcher to x-ray table and in/out of rooms
- Assist staff with patient positioning and detector positioning

They may also provide emotional support and partner with the clinical staff to provide a caring, positive environment for patients.

Time Commitment:

Volunteers are scheduled for 3-4 hour shifts (Monday-Friday.) This department schedules 1 volunteer per day. Volunteers must be able to make a six-month commitment to volunteering. A minimum of 40 hours is required prior to receiving verification of volunteer work.
