Digital Mammogram	 Quick examination, 15–20 minutes Relatively small amount of radiation with instantaneous images Least expensive 	 Yearly screening for women 40 years and older is the recommended standard of care (American Cancer Society). Women under the age of 40 should consult their physician. Standard test for evaluation of breast problems such as a lump, pain or nipple discharge
Automated Full Breast Ultrasound	 30–40 minute exam Screening test for full breast with no radiation — uses sound waves Moderate cost 	 Used in conjunction with — does not replace — a mammogram Especially useful for women with breast density of 3–4 or who have breast implants
3D Digital Mammogram/ Breast Tomosynthesis	 Quick examination, 15–20 minutes Multiple images taken in each position allow the radiologist to view the images layer by layer similar to a CT scan Relatively small amount of radiation Moderate cost 	 Especially useful in patients who have denser breast tissue To evaluate a questionable finding from a previous mammogram To better evaluate the size, shape and location of a possible problem
Diagnostic Ultrasound	 30-60 minute exam A targeted exam that uses sound waves — no radiation Moderate cost 	 To evaluate a lump found during a mammogram or a physical exam Useful for determining whether a lump is fluid-filled (cyst) or a solid mass
MRI	 Longer examination, 45-60 minutes No radiation — uses magnets and radio waves Highly accurate in finding and evaluating cancers Covered by most insurance plans when clinically necessary Most expensive 	 To evaluate a questionable finding from a mammogram or an ultrasound Used in conjunction with mammography to screen women for breast cancer who are determined by their health care provider to be high risk To accurately assess the extent of a newly-diagnosed cancer in one or both breasts To monitor how cancer is responding to treatments such as chemotherapy and/or radiation therapy
