Covenant Kids is a fund managed by the Covenant HealthCare Foundation. Monies in this fund are dedicated to enhancing the care for all Covenant kids, any Covenant patient under the age of 18 and their families. Since 2010, Covenant Kids has raised more than \$900,000 to support pediatric needs of the Great Lakes Bay Region and beyond.

Covenant HealthCare is the regional leader in providing health care to children with the following services:

- Level III Regional Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (RNICU) offering the highest level of critical care for neonatal infants
- The only Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) serving mid-Michigan and the northern lower Michigan region designed to care for critically ill infants and children through the age of 17
- ACS-Verified Pediatric Trauma Center one of only six in Michigan verified to care for the whole family in an emergency
- Community-based urgent care through MedExpress
- Extensive clinical programs for children (diabetes, rehabilitation, cardiology, and more)

THE MONEY RAISED for the Covenant Kids fund has been used to purchase many items that help provide better care for our smallest patients. These items include:

Cinemavision — a device purchased to reduce anxiety experienced during a pediatric MRI and is especially useful for keeping children calm and still during the procedure.

Buzzy® — a friendly, vibrating bee that helps reduce or even eliminate the needle pain. By placing Buzzy® above the injection site, the sensation confuses the nerves and distracts the child's attention away from the needle stick.

Grants and Donations — \$76,300 have provided the Covenant HealthCare Regional Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (RNICU) with a digital retina camera (RetCam), the first of its kind in the region, and one of only five in the state. RetCams are used to diagnose premature infants with Retinopathy of Prematurity, an eye disease that when undetected or untreated can lead to blindness.

Adaptive Imaging Device — used in the isolette to provide faster images with less radiation all within the comfort of the warm isolette and less disturbing for the baby.

WE ARE PASSIONATE about the work we do and the responsibility we have to support the medical needs of children in our community. The Covenant Kids Telethon is one facet of ongoing philanthropic activities in our community to support the Covenant Kids Fund.
