# **SUPPLIES TO CONSIDER**

#### **AGES 0-2**

- One board book
- Rattle, learning keys or nesting/stacking toy
- Sippy cup or teething ring

#### **AGES 2-6**

- Disney characters or farm animals
- Science or nature items
- One sheet of girl/boy themed stickers
- One small board book for ages 2-3 and 4-6
- One coloring book and a pack of crayons
- One toy car

### **AGES 7-12**

- One coloring book and a pack of crayons
- Card game such as Go Fish, Crazy 8's or UNO
- One small book
- Magazines such as: Sports Illustrated Kids, Highlights, National Geographic Kids, American Girl, Discovery Girls, Kids Discover, National Geographic Little Kids or Girls Life
- Bubbles (individual non-toxic bottles)

### AGES 13 AND UP OR CAREGIVER

- One adult word search, crossword or coloring book
- One package of colored pencils
- Card games such as Phase 10, UNO or Skip Bo
- Writing journal
- Nail polish, body wash, deodorant, lotion, etc.

### **ASSEMBLING FUN PACKS**

Items for Fun Packs should be placed in a gallon-sized sealable bag. Place a Fun Pack label on the bag or print on paper and insert into bag. Labels can be printed from covenantkidsmi.com on Avery 5163 shipping labels.



### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED**

The health, safety and privacy of our patients is our top priority. We ask that Covenant Kids Fun Packs do not contain the following:

- Gently used books, magazines and toys
- Food or food-themed items (due to dietary restrictions)
- Objects smaller than a quarter (choking hazard)
- Products that contain latex or toxins (check labels carefully)
- Items that have been stored or displayed for any length of time
- Products that promote violence (guns, swords, etc.)
- Elements that are connected to a religious holiday
