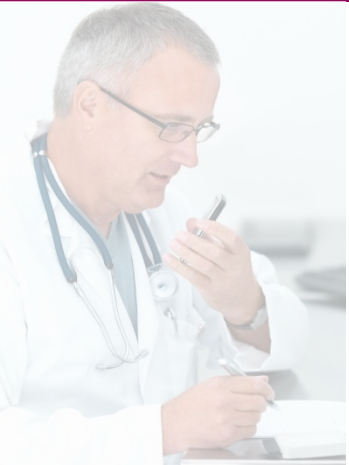

MIOSHA – EMERGENCY RULE

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) (SECTION 6)

Rule 5

Health surveillance for all employers.

(1) Conduct a daily entry self-screening protocol for all employees or contractors entering the workplace, including, at a minimum, a questionnaire covering symptoms and suspected or confirmed exposure to people with possible COVID-19.

MIOSHA – EMERGENCY RULE

DAILY ENTRY SELF-SCREENING PROTOCOL AND ILLNESS REPORTING

If you are ill or have any symptoms of COVID-19: Contact your manager to report your absence.

Symptoms of COVID-19

- New onset of shortness of breath
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Fever (>100.0)
- Chills
- Body aches or muscle pain
- Headache
- Loss of smell or taste

MIOSHA – EMERGENCY RULE

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) (SECTION 10)

Rule 7

Training requirements for all employers.

(3) The training shall cover:

- (a) Workplace infection-control practices. (#IP.309 COVID-19)
- (b) The proper use of personal protective equipment.
- (c) Steps the employee must take to notify the business or operation of any symptoms of COVID-19 or a suspected or confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19.
- (d) How to report unsafe working conditions.

WORKPLACE INFECTION CONTROL PRACTICES

#IP.309 – COVID-19

- PUI/Positive Patient Placement Procedures
- Rule out, Presumed or Confirmed COVID
 - First choice for bed placement is a Negative Pressure Room
 - Negative pressure rooms should be utilized for patients undergoing aerosol-generating procedures.
 - Place order for Contact and Airborne Isolation
 - When a negative pressure room is unavailable place patient first in a private room. Lastly, place in a semi-private room
 - Place order for Contact and Droplet Isolation
 - Guidelines for Cohorting Positive COVID patients
 - Cohort on designated units
 - Positive COVID, no other active respiratory pathogens or co-infections
 - No aerosol generating procedures, unless both vented
