Hard Stop to be Added to PT/OT Orders if No Reason for Referral Entered

Due to HFAP standard 26.00.05 a hard stop had to be add to all therapy orders if a reason for the referral order is not completed. As of March 13, 2017 all PT/OT orders will have a “Pre-selected” reason for referral order, which will read: “Reason for PT Order: Decreased functional mobility and/or other (to be indicated in Comments),” and the “Reasons for OT Order: Decreased activities of daily living and/or other (to be indicated in Comments).” A comment is not required, however, the physician can still indicate a comment if specific needs are indicated.

If you remove the pre-selected reason for the referral, you will get a hard stop that causes you to re-select the reason before signing. If you have any additional questions, please contact Cherie Bremer at 989.583.4020.
