Major Changes in Resuscitation Terminology

The Covenant Resuscitation Policy revision will go live April 18, 2017. The policy was revised to make it easier to differentiate DNR with Comfort Measures Only from a basic DNR order, align with current AHA and Michigan healthcare organization terminology and allow patients and families to better understand the process.

We have clarified and renamed several code orders:

DNR w/out Comfort Measures will now be called DNAR (Do Not Attempt Resuscitation),

No Code w/ Comfort Measures Only will now be called AND-CMO (Allow Natural Death – Comfort Measures Only),

Partial Code will now be called Specified Resuscitation.

Code Orders can be accessed by typing the individual order names or simply "Code". As a reminder, per Medical Staff Rules, a Code Status Order is required on all admitted patients.
