Covenant HealthCare, in collaboration with the Michigan Opioid Prescribing Engagement Network (OPEN), Burt Watson Chevrolet and Saginaw Police Department will host a Medication Take Back event on Saturday, September 30, 10:00am to 2:00pm outside 800 Cooper. This allows community members to drive-thru and drop off unwanted or unused prescription medications, including pills and capsules (no liquid filled), patches, pet medications and expired or unwanted prescriptions (including controlled substances). However, no needles, syringes, inhalers, lancets or liquids will be accepted. The event will be coordinated with City of Saginaw Police Department, with officers and Covenant employee volunteers on-site.
